- Get to Know the Pool + Gym started last week.
- Fitness program running in April.
- Community Helpers and QPR Suicide Prevention training coming up.
- Tasha will be doing Mental Health First Aid for seniors on March 29th and 30th.
- The library is running *From the Stacks* seniors story time 2 times a month. They have snacks and drinks.
