

Early Childhood Community Conversation Notes - Oct. 12th, 2022

TRENDS:

- Training of lifeguards was delayed during C19 = shortage of lifeguards now.
- The Aquatic Centre needs more facilitators to increase capacity and meet demand for swimming lessons. 41 Junior Lifeguard Club registered + 280 private lessons last year.
- Community Outreach Services (COS) is seeing very complex situations families are facing. COS offers referral to trauma counselling for families. Funding is available for complex mental health situations or historical disclosures.
- Barrier to running playgroup more days a week =difficult to arrange set up.
- More kids at library.

- Fire emergency set back fitness & aquatic team by a month

- Indoor Playgroup begins first week Nov. Wed & Fri 10-12
- Oct 31 Halloween Party to launch indoor playgroup
- Baby & Me, Thursdays 1-3 @ 627.
- Book lovers weekend, Live Author readings inc. 'On the Mountain top' 3pm 21st. Bookstore and Habitat writing workshops
- Settlement Services offering a Welcome to Winter and Tax info programs
