### TRENDS:

- People want to come back indoors as the weather cools.
- More Ukrainians are starting to leave Jasper.
- Lack of hours with businesses.
- Pharmacies can now do COVID Pfizer vaccination for 5-11 year olds.
- 335 jobs listed on the job board at the Jasper Employment and Education Centre. Many employers are understaffed. There is an increase in seasonal work.
- Seeing lots of people needing Fitness/Aquatic pass renewals.
- APR.1 2024 Government of Alberta is making changes to regional model for victim services.
- Victim Services has been busy in Jasper with a few calls related to sudden deaths.

# **COMMUNITY UPDATES:**

- A new ice plant is coming for the Jasper Arena.
- The larger renovation of Jasper's recreation facilities will include universal change rooms.
- The location of the current dog park may change.
- The Jasper Park Cycling Association (JPCA) has given the bike park to the Municipality.
- Commemoration and Centennial parks are getting some enhancements garden boxes, a cook shelter, inclusive swing at Centennial and natural play structures at Commemoration.
- Robson and Lion's Park engagement on draft designs is coming soon. Skating rinks are coming this winter at Robson and Lion's parks.
- Council has focused on community health and is taking a priority-based budgeting approach.
