Day for Awareness of Missing & Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls (MMIWG) May 5th

WHEREAS, we honour the lives of MMIWG by raising awareness of this ongoing national tragedy, and we hold in our thoughts the families and communities who live with the grief of losing loved ones; and,

WHEREAS, Information and Education about MMIWG in Canada raises awareness, and supports the Municipality of Jasper to continue along the path of reconciliation.
