# Wildflowers Childcare – Lisa Daniel, Childcare Services Manager

- Summer Fun registration is now open
- Lots of families are looking for weekly care vs. all season
- Hiring went well and the daycare/out of school care teams are fully staffed
- There is a trend of families using screens as a childcare tool as they are juggling several jobs and very busy schedules. Culturally, this seems more prevalent among newcomer families.
- The daycare is seeing an increasing number of children with speech pathology needs/support.

The last 3 rec room programs happening before the program heads outdoors in July. Tor is looking for activities to do with youth if anyone has ideas or the ability to share a skill.
- Mental Health Awareness Week activities have been really successful.
