- Short two mental health positions for quite some time. Therapist travelling from Hinton every week for local appointments. Virtual support is available as well. Keep making referrals and book appointments normally as it reflects the need and AHS will feel the requests as best they can.
- Drop-in Thursday afternoons first come first served for folks where making an appointment might be a barrier.

#### **Community Outreach Services – Tor Begg Youth Outreach**

- Showing *Migration* movie on Friday, March 15: 9:30-11:30 in the library.
- Cubs and Play once a month going well (expanded scope of program).
- Need for basic essentials is still high. Financial stress prevails.
- Shout-out to Totem for giving 30 sets of skis for an event at Whistler's Campground.
- Gender Sexuality Alliance will be involved in Pride in April again.
- Speaker Series coming in the Fall.
- Seeing very different rules in families around use of technology and there are implications on how teens engage with technology.
- Seeing lots of kids that could use Educational Psychologists and finances are a barrier to be able to access one.
- Starting mid-march on Thursdays at noon will be a Caregiver Support Group (for anyone who is a caregiver of adults or children).

- Men's Shed agreement with Council to find a space.
- Opportunity for funding: CN will pay up to a certain amount per hour of volunteering for current or retired railroaders towards a charity of their choice.
- Transit: Council has directed administration to gather proposals to build a building to store the busses for review. Grant funding will cover 80% of the cost of building the building, bikes and busses.
- Jasper is blessed in that we've pooled resources with school boards and parks Canada to create a system together to reduce the cost to the tax payer alone and increases reliability.
