Municipality of Jasper Community Development - Lisa Riddell

- Engage Jasper Social Assessment, Community Guide, Community Diners, Emergency Planning

- Community and Economic Development Fund (CEDF) open until March 15

Alberta Health Services – Ryan Verge

- Still short staffed for mental health in Jasper
- Hinton has been providing support
- Anyone can still reach out and access support
- Drop-in services for addictions Thursdays 1-4pm. No pre-screening necessary.

Friends of Jasper NP

- Recipient of the Oilers 50/50 together with Food Bank and Jasper Minor Sports
- Getting ready for summer staff: difficulty with housing as always/cost of living

Jasper Food Bank

- Highest ever recorded numbers at the food bank in February: 167
- Used to have 120-130 (70 bags of food). Now up to 100 bags of food
- Coldest Night of the Year fundraiser was really successful raising roughly \$18K for the Food Bank and the Jasper Community Team Society
- Working towards becoming an accredited food bank in order to access grant funding and monthly allotments from Food Banks Canada.

Councillor Waxer

- Most controversial thing that happened was the transit hub. Council has directed Administration to go ahead and get quotes on building a building to house the busses.
- Councillor Waxer has heard some positive stories about the Transit Service so far.
- Interesting presentation about the Climate Resilience Group that included things we could be planning for with regards to climate change. Incorporate opportunities for cooling in outdoor environments.

Community Outreach – Janeen Keelan

• Inability to pay for housing and life. Working with older adults primarily. Not necessarily connected to wage, more about addictions and cost of living.

Jasper Employment and Education Centre (JEEC) – Jennifer

- Running English Language Classess M-Th, evenings. More available for daytime classes coming soon.
- Partnership with Windmill Micro-lending (low-barrier loans for newcomers to Canada) intended to help an individual to re-start a career in Canada. Can go towards credential recognition.
- TFW program. Most sessions in March are about taxes.

People want to use JEEC

Mamawichihitowin Program – Jennifer Russell

- Services for complex PTSD for violence and colonial trauma
- 13 therapists, 2 of which cover clients in Jasper
- Unprecedented level of referrals. Jasper = six month wait time. Used to be a month but went up in the last year and a half. Referrals are for individuals or whole family systems. Referral sources are victim services, childrens services, COS and other workers.
- Alberta Supports Income Support Benefits Donna Christensen
- Increase in need due to new Canadians and cost of living (data follow up)
- Work out of the Hinton office.
- Increase in refugee claimant applicants.
- Eased up restrictions on clients coming into the physical office. Now it's open again without restriction.
- File review going on for clients that are expected to work or be able to work.

- Wrapping up Wednesday evening programming with JasperLIFE (free popcorn)
- Community Helpers (peer to peer support) coming up April 10 and 17 (evenings).
