TRENDS:

- The cardboard influx from the holidays is noticeable in town.
- In Hinton, there is a person who monitors what goes where. Could that be of value in Jasper? Hinton has 3 levels of plastic sorting:
- 1) Hard plastic,
- 2) Containers,
- 3) Film/Bags/Bubble wrap
- There is interest in 'green' burials, meaning no embalmment and no lead-lined caskets, the use of compostable caskets.
- Could we separate box board from corrugated cardboard? Could summer students (using a grant) help with recycling?
- Could we set up a Municipality of Jasper recycling tour as well as the transfer station?
- Glass is getting picked up in Hinton and then put into the dump in Hinton.
- We need better communication about garbage and recycling.
