Ahneen/aaniin [ahh-nee-n]
(Hi, casual)



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Migwetch [mee-gwe-ch]
(Thank you)



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Dane-zaa (Beaver)

Danit'e/Je aa haanach'e [Dan-it-ay]
(How are you? singular)



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Wuujo aasanaláá?
(Thank you)



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Nêhiyawêwin (Cree)

Tansi [dahn-say]
(How are you?)



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Kinanâskomitin [kin-anna-skom-it-in]
(Thank you, I am grateful to you)



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Michif (Métis)

Tawnshi/Taanishi/taanshii [dawn-sheh]
(How are you?)



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Maarsii – [mar-see]
(Thank you)



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Stoney Nakoda

Âba/Umba Wathtech [umba wash-stitch]
(Hello, common greeting)



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Îsnîyes [liss-nee-yis]
(Thank you)



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Secwepemctsin (Shuswap)

Weyt-k [why-t-k]
(Hello, to one person)



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Kukwstsétsemc [kukw-stsé-tsemc]
(Thanks to you (singular), I am so fortunate)



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
