

Early Childhood + School Age Community Conversation Notes: April 12th, 2023

TRENDS:

- Jasper Victim Services Unit was quiet over the Easter long weekend.
- Community Outreach Services is really busy. They are making a lot of referrals to the Hinton Wellness Program that offers therapy for survivors of trauma.
- Lots of people are asking for babysitters.
- An increase in requests to cover the cost of recreation programming.
- There has been great collaboration for the Jasper Pride Festival this year.
- The Pride Festival did encounter a couple of instances of "Pinkwashing" which is an interest in taking part that is more of a cash grab instead of genuine support. They are also worried about protesters showing up at events. There has been an increase in anti-pride demonstrations at drag events within the province.
- A lot of new moms are visiting the pool.
- The Kayak Club is really popular. 75% of attendees are youth.
- There are an increasing number of male youth going to the gym on Friday nights.
- The pool is seeing an increase in adult private lesson requests.
- Food insecurity continues to grow and be prevalent among young children, school age children, teens and their families.
- Food Bank continues to see record numbers of people showing up.
- Alberta Health Services (AHS) is seeing an uptick in third party referrals which are referrals from parents and employers. There are also changes coming to addictions/mental health treatment facilities. Shorter wait times and increase in length of stay. All covered under AHS.
- The group also discussed a rise in popularity of a hydration drink called "Prime".

COMMUNITY UPDATES:

- The RCMP will be covering the cost for Pedal Pushers, a program that teaches young children about safe cycling within the town, following road rules, signaling etc.
- Kids want to go to the trampoline park for the next KAOS event.
- The bike park should be ready in a month. The trails are not ready yet.
- The Municipality received a 6.5 million dollar grant for housing.
- Council has directed the town administration to look into town-wide internet.
- Paid parking: Residents will need to register their vehicle only once per year.
- The Municipality is sponsoring a wall (the one by the tennis court) for the Uplift festival. The artist "Ola Volo" will be painting.
- 11 group swimming lessons sets are running right now. The demand for swimming lessons continues to be high.
- Climbing Club is wrapping up for the season.
- Indoor Playgroup is wrapping up for the season.
- The daycare is going to be doing a session with Aynsley Graham for their staff on non-violent crisis intervention on Saturday the 15th 8:30-4:30PM.
- There is no more ammonia plant outside of the daycare entrance. Hurray!
- Summer fun registration is coming up.
