TRENDS:

- Increase in people losing their homes. Rents going up, housing attached to employment and new job doesn't have housing etc.
- Inflation is making food really expensive lower income feeling more pressure.
- Food Bank seeing higher numbers than during COVID (the highest numbers they've ever seen)
- Jobs are slowing down and people are worried about hours.
- There's not enough staff at the pool to meet needs the demand is really high.

COMMUNITY UPDATES:

- Culture Night was a great success. Over 400 people came out.

UPCOMING PROGRAMS OR EVENTS:

- Coat Rescue still happening, in need of coats for the program.
- Swim lessons are full.
- Parent + tot swim at the pool will be starting in November.

- Budget presentations happening in November.
- Library of Things is almost ready to launch.
- Community Guide is in final stages for release in 2023.
- 2-punch pass coming at the pool after an orientation.
- Santas Anonymous will be launching soon.
- Community Dinners are in the works for 2023.
