

Adults Community Conversation Notes: January 4th, 2023

TRENDS:

- Global recession is forecasted to be on its way in 2023.
- Businesses need to pay Federal COVID relief money back.
 - The top three issues cited by business owners as challenges:
 - 1. Housing
 - 2. Building permit process
 - 3. Municipal taxes
- Affordability and accessibility of commercial space is also a concern.
- There is a higher demand for skilled labour and an increased need for post-secondary education that aligns with business needs.
- Business owners are feeling a sense of dissatisfaction in Jasper compared to other parts of the region. All of the West Yellowhead Region is short-staffed.
- Health: acute care referrals to addictions and mental health have increased since Christmas. They are seeing long wait times to get into a mental health facility.
- There is increased comfort in attending things (including therapy) virtually.
- Newcomers are interested in starting businesses.
- Employers are more willing to sponsor staff. Lots of requests for job postings.

COMMUNITY UPDATES:

- Commercial insurance is required to be a contractor for the municipality. The Municipality of Jasper's required liability went from 2 million to 5 million.
- A full time Mental Health Therapist position is currently posted.
- Sprinkler line broke in the Fitness and Aquatic Centre. They are using a side entrance while it gets repaired.
- Report to council on the renovation is happening soon.
