

Seniors Community Conversation Notes: June 7th, 2023

TRENDS:

- Jasper Seniors' Society (JSS) have noted more people looking for ways to get involved in the society.
- Fitness and Aquatic Centre noticing that adults who live alone and come to the gym/pool regularly will reach out if they aren't coming to stay connected.
- Service Canada in-person services are not meeting the need for services. Getting an appointment is difficult and the availability of the service is unpredictable.
- Alberta Supports' Income Support continues to be difficult to access.
- Jasper Employment and Education Centre (JEEC) is seeing older adults interested in work but they are limited by their skills or experience.

COMMUNITY UPDATES:

- Shout out of appreciation to the seniors who volunteer in the community. Especially impressed by volunteers at the Grand Fondo event.
- Shout out to Jasper Theater for using local seniors' voices in their current production.
- Library is looking for seniors to read to seniors.
- L'Association Canadienne Francaise de Jasper (ACFA) is open to ideas and suggestions for French programming for seniors.
- Free Fitness and Aquatic Centre memberships for seniors 75+ continues and has been greatly appreciated.
- JEEC's Seniors resume program is receiving interest and uptake.
- Racquet courts and volleyball courts are now open
- Verhey Friendly Visiting is now offering services full time. Adult day programming for social and physical well-being to launch in the summer.
- Alberta Health Services (AHS) will host a 'Town Hall' event for community feedback on services. Date to be announced.
- AHS & Fitness Centre looking into running the physio program again in the fall.
- Aquatic Centre will be closed for renovations from September 5th through to at least November. Looking into use of private pools to continue some programming during pool closures.
- Soup program still running daily in Activity Centre
- Seniors Society will promote new membership in the Fall.
- Anger Management for men course through AHS coming in September.
- Council updates:
 - Council proclaimed June 5-11, 2023, as Seniors' Week in Jasper and reminded all that our seniors provide an invaluable foundation for our community.
 - The Protection for Vulnerable Residential Tenants resolution was seconded by the Town of Edson for submission to Alberta Municipalities. Details and draft Resolution are available to read in the <u>April 18th Regular Council Meeting</u> <u>Agenda</u> (See Agenda item 6.6, pages 36-39). The resolution will be published in Alberta Municipalities 2023 Resolutions book, to be released August 2, 2023.



- Routes and cost report for new Public Transportation Plan are underway with a report expected by fall.
- Looking into approval of patio variances for businesses
- <u>Extended Producer Responsibility Regulation</u> program for recycling is now in effect for Alberta. Alberta Government expect this will be fully operational by April, 2025.
- JEEC will be advocating and raising awareness for Menopause friendly workplaces.
- Compass for the Caregivers training coming in September: Course teaches resources, boundaries, and self-care for caregivers.
- Emilie Langley is the new Director for ACFA.
- JEEC will have a new Executive Director starting in July. Ginette to stay on until end of year.
- JEEC Astra has moved into the Temporary Foreign Workers role, Alisen Charlten in adult learning.
